POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

The rules and regulations listed below are for the safety and welfare of Wembly pool members and their guest. It is your duty to keep them in mind while using the pool facility.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE RULES COULD LEAD TO MEMBERSHIP SUSPENSION.

1. Lifeguards have complete authority to enforce all rules & regulations. Any appeal of the decision of a lifeguard should be made to the Pool Manager and then to the pool board of directors.
2. In the event of an emergency or adverse weather, the lifeguard or Pool Manager will clear the pool with a signal of three (3) blasts of the whistle. NOT RE-ENTER the pool until permission is given.
3. Anyone with special medical or physical requirements should make them known to the Pool Manager. Use of pool facilities is dependent on the ability to maintain safety for all.
4. Wembly does NOT assume responsibility for the protection or safekeeping of member's (or their guests) valuables.
5. All members (over 12) MUST sign in with the gatekeeper for themselves, or their children (under 12) and/or and their guests. Guest fees are \$5 per person. Children under the age of 6 - no charge.
6. Glass, breakable containers, and intoxicating beverages are NOT ALLOWED on or around Wembly pool area. **Smoking is only allowed outside of the fence and upper deck area .**
7. Chewing gum is PROHIBITED in or around the pool.
8. Earphones or headsets are required on ALL audio equipment.
9. There will be periodic adult swims (18 and over). During these periods infants under age 2 will be permitted with parent(s).
10. Adults (18 and over) have priority on the lounge chairs. Lounge chairs are to remain in upright position .
11. ALL children (members or guest) UNDER the age of 12, must be supervised by a person age 14 or older to which responsibility has been delegated by the parent.
12. The baby pool is only for children UNDER 6. Children must be supervised by an adult or qualified person age 14 or older to which responsibility has been delegated by the parent.
13. Running, pushing, throwing others in pool and other rough play is forbidden. The lifeguard or Pool Manager is free take disciplinary measures.
14. Bathing attire is to be changed in restrooms ONLY, with the exception of diapering babies in the BABY POOL area.

15. Parents - instruct your children in personal hygiene and use of the restroom facilities. Also, trashcans are provided for disposal of candy wrappers, trash, cans, etc. Litter is unsightly and attractive to bees and other stinging insects.
16. Swimming aids are not allowed in the main pool (snorkels, facemasks, swimmies, etc.), only Coast Guard APPROVED flotation devices are permitted.
17. Kick boards will be used only under supervision of lifeguard or swim team coach. Basketball or other games, will only be permitted at the discretion of lifeguard or Pool Manager.
18. A lane is provided for lap swimming ONLY. Other swimmers are not to cross the lap lane or otherwise interfere with lap lane swimmers.
19. Rinse sand off feet before entering pool after volleyball court use.
20. Only persons with adequate swimming ability may use the diving area. In the interest of safety, the lifeguard shall have the authority to require any person, regardless of age, to demonstrate adequate swimming ability by completing a non-stop swim across the width of the pool.
21. Only one person on the diving board at a time. The next diver should wait on the deck until the board is empty. One bounce per dive; no running on the board and no hanging off end of board. Dive straight off the end of board. Never exit the deep well by climbing out on the walls. After a dive, swim directly to a ladder and then exit. Do not swim directly in front of the board. No sitting or standing on, diving from or jumping over the ladders.
23. No diving where prohibited by painted signs saying "No Diving" No diving permitted from sides of pool where water is 5 feet or less.

In the interest of safety, these rules & regulations are subject to change without notice. Please direct all questions and/or concerns to the Pool Manager.
